

**Inbal Reuveni**, M.D. is the director of the Women's Integrated Mental-Health Service at Hadassah University Medical Center, Jerusalem, Israel. She is a graduate of the Joyce and Irving Goldman Medical School, Ben-Gurion, University of the Negev, Beer-Sheba, Israel. She completed her residency in Adult Psychiatry at the Department of Psychiatry, Hadassah-Hebrew University Medical Center. Between 2018-2019 Dr. Reuveni joined the Perinatal Pathways Lab under the mentorship of Dr. Catherine Monk as an Adjunct Associate Research Scientist. Her current research focuses on the neurobiological imprint of exposure to childhood trauma and perinatal mood and anxiety disorders. Upon her return to Israel at the end of 2019 Dr. Reuveni launched a new integrated-care program centered on Women's Mental Health. This service seeks to embed high-quality mental health interventions within the maternal health care services of the Obstetrics and Gynecology Department. This initiative increases access to mental health for women during pregnancy, postpartum and for women undergoing fertility treatments.
